


BLOCK 10, ROBERT REED'S ADDITION TO ULYSSES

FIELD NOTES


This survey was prepared at the request of Ron Schultz, Wish Nebraska, Inc., Ulysses, Nebraska. Reference: Field Bk. 1 p.58. Mr. Schultz stated that the alley in Blk. 10 is presently proposed to be vacated. The validity of this survey is contingent upon said alley being vacated, by the Village of Ulysses, as proposed. At A and B, found 1/2" rebars, as recorded by myself (10-8-1984; Microfilm Bk. 85 p.29). At C, D, and H, found 1" iron pipes, as recorded by Tremel (5-20-1996; Microfilm Bk. 96 p.1199). D is in broken E-W sdwk. Set E on line A-B extended. Set F on line and at proportionate distance between E and D. Set G on line and at proportionate distance between A and C.

DESCRIPTION


Lots 5, 6, 7, and 8, Block 10, Robert Reed's Addition to West Ulysses, Butler County, Nebraska, and that part of the vacated alley lying between said Lots 5 and 6, and said Lots 7 and 8 of said Block 10.
