FIELD NOTES


This survey was prepared at the request of Carroll Krivanek, Abie Village Board, Abie, Nebraska. Reference: Field Bk. 50 p.10. At A, found 5/8" iron bar 0.2' deep, as recorded by myself (11-18-2003; Microfilm Bk. 04 p.69). At B, found 5/8" iron bar 0.3' deep, recorded by Zieman (3-27-1995; Survey Bk. 12 p.91) as a 3/4" iron bar. At C, found 1" iron pipe 0.3' deep, as recorded by Zieman (3-27-1995; Survey Bk. 12 p.91). Set D and E, on line B-C. D is 80' east of B. E is at proportionate distance between B and C. I computed the proportionate lot dimensions, using the Zieman survey, and set F and G at locations shown. F is a hole in concrete sidewalk, 0.75' south and 0.15' west of SW corner building. G is a 5/8" x 24" smooth iron bar with plastic cap marked "LS 383", at east side of buried concrete footing.

The north line of Lot 12, Block 4, Original Town of Abie, Butler County, Nebraska.
